Every year Glasgow City Mission distributes over 9,000 food parcels to people who are homeless and disadvantaged in Glasgow. Just like a traditional harvest, the Mission collects all of its food at one time, creating stock for the entire year.

The Glasgow Academy Atholl arranges a collection of food items week beginning 3rd October. This is also our Enterprise Week so the pupils will be organising the collection along with the P.T.A.

Food parcels include:

- tinned food - beans, spaghetti, fruit, vegetables, tuna, meat, puddings

The Mission is also looking for:

- coffee, diluting juice, sugar

In order to comply with current health and safety legislation, the Mission **can no longer accept:**

- jars of sauce, dried pasta, rice
