

Guidelines For Reading Logs

Please note that the 'Parental Reading Handbook' can be accessed from the parental section on the school web-site from next week; this contains tips for reading at home, recommended reading timings and also contains a link to our on-line reading lists for each year group.

At Home

- Pupils should fill this in at home after they have completed each home-reader (*not school reading books*).
- There is a parental section at the back of the Reading Log for parents to write comments about books that their child has read; this could lead to recommendations for the school library or possibly novel studies in *Transitus*.

At School

- To be looked at every second Tuesday during Literacy Time.
- Teacher to feedback on books read and on pupil observations made; are books challenging enough, are pupils enjoying their books, are pupils reading enough?
- Pupils may wish to discuss each other's records to encourage discourse about books; this may lead to suggestions for what pupils wish to read next.
- Pupils will be set reading targets each month; they will be rewarded with house points or similar for successfully achieving targets.
