We are extremely flexible to meet you and your children's needs and your working pattern. You can choose to mix and match your days e.g. have a full-time day on a Wednesday and only mornings on the other days, if these sessions are available.

KELVINBRIDGE NURSERY



- Flexible options are available. For example, if you attend three days a week then 6/10ths will be calculated. The minimum number of sessions you can attend is 5 per week.
- You are invoiced monthly whether your child is attending term-time or full-time.
- Lunches are included in your fee except for sessions 9.00 am - noon, 1.00 pm - 4.00 pm or 1.00 pm - 6.00 pm

The Glasgow Academy Kelvinbridge Nursery is an extension to the existing quality care service the school has to offer in Nursery, Pre-Primary and After School Care provision at Kelvinbridge.

The nursery is here to offer a flexible service to parents of nursery children aged between 3 and 4 years of age. The children can then move into Pre-Primary for their pre-school year aged 4 - 5 years of age. The nursery is open for a longer day than the normal school and we are also open in the holiday periods. When the children move up to Pre-Primary they can still attend 8am - 6pm when they come along to our After School Care service which is open for breakfast club, after school care and holiday clubs.

The children are in one area for their nursery year and then move into a new area for their pre-primary year.

The nursery ethos is very much learning through active play. The children are involved in choosing the daily activities, what they would like for snacks and the themes they want to learn about e.g. this week it is pets and vets.

The children have access to outside play on a daily basis. They also move around the school community, taking physical activities in the After School Care area and lunch in the school dining hall.

The nursery is in partnership with Glasgow City Council, therefore pre-school funded places are available. You should pay your monthly invoices as normal and three times a year when the funding is received by the school the funding amounts are refunded to you.

The nursery is a registered service with the Care Commission and therefore inspected regularly in delivering a quality service meeting our National Care Standards.

As with all our nursery children there is no guarantee that the children will "automatically" move into PI at the Glasgow Academy. All children going into PI are assessed by Preparatory School staff.

The Nursery Staff

The staff offer a friendly and welcoming nursery: they are there to help you and your child/children take the first steps into education. They are accommodating and ready to answer any questions you may have.

Our staff are all employed by The Glasgow Academy. They are qualified to meet the Scottish Social Services Council criteria for the childcare workforce.
