Nepal Project 2012 Update

Happy New Year: I hope you all had great time over the break. As you will know the group were busy in the first two weeks of term with sweet and cakes sales which added nearly £200 to the pot. As a result, fundraising remains on track and the fundraising contribution to the February payment has been met.

It would be our aim to have the £150 fundraising instalment for March paid from the pupils personal fundraising to allow time for the group to work towards securing more lucrative group fundraising activities. While we are continuing to approach supermarkets for a bag-packing event we have been unsuccessful so far in our efforts.

Projects Abroad have been in contact with two project options. One is at the Clark Memorial School in the Kathmandu valley. The school is a charity-run schools for 90 migrant children. The second is at the J & K House which is a children's home for orphans. I have asked for more details from the company on both of these options and also for them to look into others for us to consider.
