Please find below details of Sundays mountaineering.

We will go to Glencoe, although the destination may change if the weather forecast looks significantly better elsewhere. Currently, the forecast is for local showers, 13 degrees centigrade and moderate easterly winds.

We will be accompanied by Mr Horgan, and my partner, Mark Davidson, who is a full-time lecturer at Forth Valley College in Stirling and holds the Mountain Instructor Certificate.

Pupils should bring warm and waterproof clothing for a full mountain day. They should also bring walking boots, harness and helmet if they have them. A flask, hat and several sets of gloves are advisable. Each pupil should inform me before Friday of the kit they are bringing, and arrange to collect the items that they do not already have. We will stop off at the Good Food Café on our way back down the road if the group is hungry, so please also bring money for this.

We will meet at The Academy at 0700 on Sunday and aim to be back there by 1900 hours, though parents will be informed if this time does change.
