**Arrangements for P5 girls, P6 and P7 Games-Hockey and Rugby-new session.**

Dear Parents,

Your son or daughter will be having Games sessions this term on a Friday afternoon for P5, 6 and 7 and on Monday afternoons for P6 and 7. I am writing to update P5 girls' parents on one matter and to pass on the arrangements regarding games for all of P6 and P7.

The update concerns the P5 girls who *will* require Astro turf trainers when attending their hockey at Jordanhill Sports Club on Anniesland Road, G13 1YQ and will be doing hockey on Lower Windyedge Astro turf pitch. The reason for including this here is that it is not mentioned on the uniform list for games as this is a new venue for this year. All P5, P6 and P7 pupils will be going out to Anniesland for Games and will be leaving from school at 2.30pm and travelling via McColl's coaches. The finish and collection time for all of these pupils will be at 4.15pm at each venue. P6 and P7 girls will be at Top Windyedge Astro turf in Ryvra Road, G13 1XW and P6 and P7 boys will be at the School ground on Anniesland Road, G13 1XS. Please contact [enquiries@tga.org.uk](mailto:enquiries@tga.org.uk) should you need information regarding parent-organised transport arrangements, plus if your daughter or son makes their own way home from either of these venues that is perfectly acceptable; however, I would be grateful if you could possibly inform me as to this particular intention.

There will also be a Cross-Country Club open to all pupils in P5, P6 and P7, after Games on Fridays starting on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> September. This will be at Top Windyedge Astro on Ryvra Road and will finish at 5.15pm. If your daughter or son would like to be involved in this club they should be collected from here at 5.15pm. In this case there will be no school-organised transport and pupils should either be collected or make their own way home. Further information about this club will be given to the pupils on their return to school in August; however this particular information might help you to plan your collection arrangements on Fridays.
