**Arrangements for S3 Games-Hockey and Rugby-new session.**

Dear Parents,

Your son or daughter will be having Games sessions this term on Tuesday afternoons for S3. I am writing to pass on the arrangements regarding games for the first two terms.

The boys will be at the School ground on Anniesland Road, G13 1XS and the girls will be at Jordanhill Sports Club on Anniesland Road, G13 1YQ and will be doing hockey on the Lower Windyedge Astroturf pitch. All pupils will be going out to Anniesland for Games and will be leaving from school at 2.30pm and travelling via McColl's coaches. The normal finish and collection time for all of these pupils will be at 4.30pm at each venue. After-school rugby for any S1, S2 and S3 boys interested in further improving their skills will be held on Wednesdays at The Academical Club, in Helensburgh Drive, G13 1RR starting on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2011. The boys will be transported out to The Academical Club by bus; however, they must be collected from there at 6pm. This particular information might help you to plan your collection arrangements on Tuesdays and/or Wednesdays. Unfortunately there will be no parent-organised school transport available after these girls' or boys' extra sessions.
