Dear Parent

In 2010, Fraser House organised for a team of Academy pupils, staff and parents to take part in Sport Relief's Mile event. This year, we have decided to support Shine, which is coming to Glasgow for the first time in September 2011, and we would like to open this event to pupils from all four Houses, not simply Fraser House. We would like as many people (pupils, parents and staff) as possible to enter Shine with us, in order to help more people beat cancer.

Shine is Cancer Research UK's night-time walking marathon. The idea is to use light as a symbol of hope and to represent the progress being made in the fight against cancer. You can choose to either walk 26.2 or 13.1 miles to raise awareness and funds for Cancer Research UK. Shine is a unique fundraising event, you can select which type of cancer you want to beat or whether you want to raise funds for their general work. Either way, you can be sure that the funds you raise will be spent wisely and where they are needed most.

Shine will take place on Saturday 10 September 7.30pm and the entry fee is £30. This goes towards the cost of staging the event, meaning that all the money you raise can be spent on the life-saving work carried out by Cancer Research.
