Unsold NON UNIFORM items must be collected by 10.30am on the day of sale, or they will be given to a suitable charity.

*The PTA has been able to gather sufficient old style uniform, particularly sports clothing and send it to a school in Africa for further use. As this is the first sale in which we will NOT BE SELLING old style sport's uniform, we would invite parents to send in the older pieces and a further shipment will be made. Thank you for your support.*

Mark each uniform item clearly on a detachable (not a stick-on) label with your name, address and postcode.

Please ensure that your full name is clearly indicated on the labels, as this will be the payee name in respect of any cheques issued.



**PRICE**

Price the uniform item (or leave that to the organisers).

**CHECK**

Check that everything is CLEAN and in GOOD CONDITION (anything badly worn or dirty will be thrown away). Spot cleaning of blazers is recommended rather than dry cleaning.

N.B. The sale will open on Saturday, 6th June 2009 at 9.00am - We're sorry but NO uniform will be available for sale on the Friday preceding the sale.
