**SQA EXAMINATIONS 2010**

Study leave for Fourth Year will be from Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> April to Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> June inclusive and for Fifth and Sixth Year will be from Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> May to Friday 4<sup>th</sup> June inclusive. Candidates with an exam before study leave begins are excused school on the day of the exam. Anyone with an exam falling after these dates will be excused until the day following the exam. All candidates should have received a copy of the examination timetable, but you should be aware that exams are scheduled for during the half term holiday as follows:

Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May      Higher and Advanced Higher Music  
                            General & Credit Physics  
                            Higher and Advanced Higher Physics  
                            Higher Economics

Monday 31<sup>st</sup> May     Higher and Advanced Higher Geography

On those days school lunch will not be available. Candidates will be required to fulfil their commitments to sports teams during the examination period.

Candidates in the Fifth and Sixth Years who have a light examination load are encouraged to come in to school during study leave and be given work by those who teach them. Any pupil on study leave who comes in to school **for any reason** must wear school uniform.

Parents are asked to ensure that on the day of their children's return to school all textbooks are handed to the member of staff who issued them. During the remainder of term the Fourth Year will start their Higher courses, Fifth Year will start their likely Sixth Year courses and a programme of post-exam activities is organised for Sixth Year. There will also be a number of sporting and co-curricular activities taking place.

Last term all candidates were issued with instructions on how to register with MySQA, an online service which will send results by e-mail or text. This is in addition to the certificate which will be sent in the post. The date for receipt of emails and text messages has been up-dated and they will now be sent between 8am and 9am on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2010.

If a pupil is absent on the day of an exam please obtain a medical certificate and submit it to us as soon as possible.

All leavers should attend Prize-Giving on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> June.
