Prep 6

Entrance Test

Children applying for P6 take the following papers:

- *Non-verbal Reasoning* - this symbols-based test is designed to assess the candidate's potential rather than achievement or knowledge. Some practice questions precede the test.
- *English Writing* - a short piece of personal or imaginative writing. Assessment will take account of story interest, vocabulary used, spelling, punctuation and grammar.
- *Mathematics* - addition and subtraction to/from 100000; multiplication; division; word problems; shapes and their properties; symmetry; use of money to £1000; fractions; a variety of graphs and tables; decimals; time; measure; co-ordinates
- *Verbal Reasoning* - this language-based test is designed to assess the candidate's potential rather than achievement or knowledge. A short practice paper precedes the test.

All parents and children are interviewed informally by the Head of the Prep School or a member of his senior team.

Prep 7/Trans

Entrance Test

Children applying for P7 take the following papers:

- *Non-verbal Reasoning* - this symbols-based test is designed to assess the candidate's potential rather than achievement or knowledge. Some practice questions precede the test.
- *English Writing* - a short piece of personal or imaginative writing. Assessment will take account of story interest, vocabulary used, spelling, punctuation and grammar.
- *Mathematics* - addition to 100000 and beyond; subtraction from 100000; multiplication; division; percentages; decimals; word problems; shapes and their properties; symmetry; use of money to £1000; time; measure, distance, perimeter and volume; fractions (tenths, twentieths, quarters etc.); co-ordinates.
- *Verbal Reasoning* - this language-based test is designed to assess the candidate's potential rather than achievement or knowledge. A short practice paper precedes the test.

All parents and children are interviewed informally by both the Rector and the Head of the Prep School or a member of his senior team.
